

## Federal Acquisition Certification in Contracting (FAC-C) (Professional) Roadmap

- A minimum of **12 months of full-time experience** applying a representative sample of the technical contracting competencies.
- Fulfilled the Office of Personnel Management (OPM)'s **1102 Hiring Qualification Standards**.
- **Completion of the following courses:**
  - CON 1100: Contract Foundational Skills
  - CON 1200: Contract Pre-award
  - CON 1300: Contract Award
  - CON 1400: Contract Post-award
- **Pass the CON 3990V Contracting Certification Exam**, a 150-question closed-book examination. Exam is graded on a pass/fail basis, with a minimum passing score of 70%.

### FAC-C (PROFESSIONAL) CERTIFICATION ELIGIBLE

#### **Continuous Learning Requirements:**

**Non-DOW Agencies:** Effective 1/21/2026: 80 continuous learning points (CLPs) are needed for certification in the current continuous learning period that ends on Apr. 30, 2026.

**DOW Agencies:** 80 continuous learning points (CLPs) every 2 years per DoDI 5000.66

**Note:** Some agencies may have additional requirements in order to obtain your FAC-C (Professional) certification. It is recommended that you consult [your ACM](#) and agency policies if you have any questions about requirements specific to your agency.
